Dear Bethany Family,

I am thankful for all that took place during our International Missions Festival this past weekend. The reports we heard should prompt us to

faithful action. Our first action should be praise to God. We should praise Him for the great work He is doing through gospel soldiers He has sent to the nations. We should praise Him for the pastors around the world who are receiving theological training



in places where they had none. We should praise Him for the advancement of His kingdom in this world.

Along with praise to God, our action should be glad obedience to send and/or go as gospel soldiers to the end of the earth. Our Lord's Great Commission to us is clear. We are to make disciples of all nations. That word, all, means we are called to reach the nations in our land and the nations on the other side of the globe. Obedience means taking the gospel to our own community. There should be no unreached people in our own communities because we are here with the gospel. But there are unreached people in so many other places around the world who have zero access to the gospel. No one is among them to tell them about Jesus. Obedience means a glad sacrifice on our part to change that reality!

Prayer is the foremost work to be done. We must persevere in prayer for the Lord of the harvest to send out workers to empower the ministry of our missionary partners on the field. We must then be willing to be used by God in His answer to our prayer—to send more missionaries by giving sacrificially. The Lottie Moon Christmas Offering is one of the primary ways that we can do so. One hundred percent of that offering goes to send and equip Southern Baptist missionaries to reach the unreached. Here are some examples of what your gifts through Lottie Moon can do:

Give \$2,000 to cover a missionary's vaccinations in preparation for the field. Give \$600 to cover a two-week intensive language study for a missionary.

Give \$60 to purchase Bible-study materials for new-believer classes.

Give \$2,500 to cover one year of homeschool supplies for missionary kids.

Give \$500 to buy leader-training manuals for local believers.

Give \$39 to buy one week of meals for a refugee family.

Give \$3,000 to cover the production of a gospel film in a new language.

Three years ago, Bethany gave \$16,604 to the Lottie Moon Offering. Two years ago: \$16,681. Last year, we gave \$17,435. Our church goal again this year is this: obedience and sacrifice. What will we give, church family? What will we sacrifice to send more gospel soldiers? Let's be devoted together to pray and obey. And may our precious Savior be made known to all nations.
